Per a message from Alan Lange, the HSCC is coordinating an exhibit display and is asking agencies and individuals for items to display that are "Report Card" related. The exhibit must highlight the Children's Report Card and can include different types of materials to exhibit, such as pictures.</li> </ul> <p><b>Committee Reports</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>Advocacy Committee:</b> The Advocacy Committee will meet with the Report Card Committee to develop a strategy to make the Report Card a more politically useful report--the report should help effect the County budget. The timing of the Report Card will also be discussed because the timing issue will increase the efficiency of the report. Also, there will be a pre-release of the data pertaining to the Sacramento County Children's Report Card. The pre-release of data will be discussed at the Steering Committee.</li> </ul> <p><b>Non-Coalition Reports</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>CAPC:</b> CAPC is working to compile information on the Coalition and will 'crunch' numbers and create a presentation about 50,000 kids who won't have access to health coverage. CAPC is also hiring an additional position to coordinate and get a comprehensive approach. The Child Death Review Team will need to provide resources—entities can work together to serve vulnerable youth. With the data on youth violence that was acquired, a "Youth Violence Review Team" was formed. Information about this team and activities will be included in the 2007 Report.</li> </ul>

<b>Mandated Reporter Training Project Update</b>	The Center for Excellence in Child Development and the Northern Training Academy, both units within the Center for Human Services at UC Davis Extension have partnered to conduct the Feasibility Study of the MRT Project. The Grant Review Committee has written a final outline, consisting of goals, objectives, and outcomes of the Feasibility Study for the MRT Project to be presented to UCD representatives at the next scheduled GRC Meeting on Nov. 29 <sup>th</sup> , 2007. At this meeting, UCD will review the outline with GRC members to concretize their role in the project.	
<b>Roundtable Discussion</b>	<b>Public Relations and Media Plan:</b> There is a focus on how to make better use of resources and use funds to reach entities outside of the Coalition. The Children's Coalition provides guidance to the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors. What is the best use of Children's Coalition time and resources? We must begin a dialogue on where to go as a group. The Coalition is a 'voice' for kids and must gain support of the County Board of Supervisors before implementation occurs.
